# NEIGHBORHOOD COST PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT CITY OF AUSTIN AND ADELPHI ACRES COMMUNITY GARDEN

#### STATE OF TEXAS

#### **COUNTY OF TRAVIS**

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between the City of Austin, Texas (the "City") and Adelphi Acres Community Garden (the "Partner"), hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties."

WHEREAS, the Partner desires to participate in developing and/or funding certain City improvements in City right-of-way or, as applicable, park space; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to participate in the development and funding of the improvements as a City project (the "Project");

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. The Project. The location and scope of the Project is described in attached Exhibit "A". The City may self-perform the design and construction of the Project or contract for such services. The Project may consist of multiple sub-projects, all of which will be developed, designed, constructed, and maintained pursuant to the terms of this Agreement.

#### 2. Project Development.

- (a) The City will manage the Project. The Project will be designed in accordance with applicable City standards, specifically including the requirements of the Texas Accessibility Standards.
- (b) In its complete discretion, the City will construct the Project with its own forces or will solicit bids for the construction of the Project. If the City contracts for the construction of the Project, the City will notify the Partner of the lowest responsible bid and, subject to available funding, enter into a firm unit-price contract with the successful bidder.
- (c) The reasonable costs to the City of its employees and equipment dedicated to the Project may be credited as an "in-kind" funding contribution.
- (d) The Partner may cost participate in the Project with funding and/or in-kind volunteer services. "Volunteer" means a person rendering services for or

on behalf of a charitable organization who does not receive compensation in excess of reimbursement for expenses incurred. The term includes a person serving as a director, officer, trustee, or direct service volunteer. A Volunteer is liable to a person for death, damage, or injury to the person or his property proximately caused by any act or omission arising from the operation or use of any motor-driven equipment, to the extent insurance coverage is required by Chapter 601, Transportation Code, and to the extent of any existing insurance coverage applicable to the act or omission. Any Volunteer providing labor or other services for or in connection with the Project will not receive any compensation in excess of reimbursement for expenses incurred. Any measurement of the value of "in-kind" volunteer services to be provided under this Agreement will not result in any direct or indirect payment to the Partner or its Volunteers or exceed the amount of expenses incurred.

## 3. Project Management.

- (a) The Designated Representative of the Partner will act on behalf of the Partner with respect to the Project and coordinate with the City.
- (b) The Director of the City's Public Works Department will act on behalf of the City with respect to the Project, coordinate with the Partner, and have complete authority to interpret and define the City's policies and decisions with respect to the Project. The Director will designate a City Project Manager and may designate other representatives to transmit instructions and act on behalf of the City with respect to the Project.

#### 4. Management Duties of the City.

- (a) The City agrees to provide to the Partner:
  - (i) written protocols for the performance of landscaping, maintenance, and other associated services by the Volunteers;
  - (ii) written copies of all contracts affecting the Project;
  - (iii) a statement of all disbursements made relating to the Project;
  - (iv) a copy of any executed change orders; and
  - (v) advance notice of the anticipated date of commencement of construction and the area to be impacted by the Project; and the date on which the Volunteer services obligations will commence.
- (b) The City is not responsible for the preservation or replacement of private improvements and landscaping in the City's right-of-way or other property which may be impacted by the construction of the Project.

#### 5. Management Duties of the Partner. The Partner hereby agrees to:

(a) Provide notice to all owners of the properties abutting the Project of the Project's anticipated schedule and the area to be impacted by the Project;

- (b) Inform the City's Project Manager immediately of any problems observed during construction or maintenance;
- (c) Attend meetings at the request of the City's Project Manager;
- (d) provide the level of funding and/or Volunteer services agreed to in this Agreement; and
- (e) ensure that each and every Volunteer, who will provide labor or other services for the Project, executes a waiver and release in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit** "C" and made a part hereof prior to performing any volunteer work or services for the Project under this Agreement.

## 6. Liability

- The Partner agrees to and shall indemnify, defend and hold the City, (a) contractors and their respective officers, its consultants and directors, partners, employees, and agents (the "INDEMNIFIED PARTIES") harmless from and against any and all claims, costs, losses, damages, and causes of action, including attorney's fees and costs of court, for personal injury, death or property damage arising out of or connected to any activities undertaken by the Partner or its Volunteers in connection with this Agreement to the extent such injury, death or damage is caused in whole or in part by any negligent act or omission of the Partner, its officers, directors, or Volunteers, regardless of whether or not caused in part by any negligence or omission of the INDEMNIFIED PARTIES hereunder or whether liability is imposed upon such INDEMNIFIED PARTY by laws and regulations regardless of the negligence of any such person or entity.
- (b) The City has obtained general liability insurance coverage in the amount of \$1,000,000 for each occurrence and \$2,000,000 in the aggregate for bodily injury or death or property damage arising out of or connected to the Volunteers activities in connection with the Project. This coverage does not apply to an act or omission that is intentional, willfully negligent, or done with conscious indifference or reckless disregard for the safety of others. In addition, this coverage is only for injury or death of third parties and damage to property of third parties and not for injury to Volunteers.
- (c) The City is a self-insured public entity and will require its contractors and consultants to provide liability, automobile, and workers compensation insurance in accordance with standard City of Austin contractual requirements.

# 7. Financial Obligations.

(a) The cost of the Project is currently estimated at \$99,447.00, including a construction contingency amount of \$3,070.00.

- (b) The Partner's share, which is based on providing funding and/or Volunteer services with an agreed-to value, is forty-nine percent (49%) of the cost of the Project. The City's share is fifty-one percent (51%) of the cost of the Project.
- (c) To the extent applicable, within 30 days of the execution of this Agreement, the Partner will pay the City the amount of \$310.00.
- (d) As provided below, the Parties will participate in funding any change orders necessary for the completion of the Project on the basis of their respective funding percentages.
- (e) The City will notify the Partner in the event additional Volunteer services or funding is needed to address Project conditions and the Partner will endeavor to provide additional Volunteers to meet the City's needs and schedules or its share of such funding within 30 days of approval by the Partner. The City will pay the remaining balance of any such cost.
- (f) Subject to the availability of funding and Volunteer participation, the City may, with a written recommendation from the Partner, adjust the Project scope to address budget constraints, legal requirements, or construction conditions.
- (g) In addition, if construction conditions, the availability of funding or other constraints restrict the City's ability to complete the Project, the City, in its complete discretion, may determine whether to pursue the Project or a portion of the Project.
- (h) The City will place any Partner's funds in a Project escrow fund. Any unused portion of the funds will be returned to the Partner within 30 days of Project completion. If applicable, the City will provide the Partner with an accounting of the Project expenses, including Partner funding, within 90 days of Project completion.
- 8. City Inspection and Testing. The City will inspect, test, and accept the Project. The Director will require the contractor to immediately take any appropriate remedial action to correct any deficiencies identified by the City or the Partner.
- 9. Additional Projects. Subject to the availability of funding or other project resources, the Parties may agree to additional projects or subprojects through an amendment to this Agreement.

#### 10. Miscellaneous.

(a) Force Majeure. In the event that the performance by the Partner or the City of any of its obligations or undertakings hereunder shall be interrupted or delayed by any occurrence not occasioned by its own conduct, whether such occurrence be an act of God, or the common

enemy, or the result of war, riot, civil commotion, sovereign conduct, or the act of conduct of any person or persons not a party or privy hereto, then it shall be excused from such performance for such period of time as it reasonably necessary after such occurrence to remedy the effects hereto.

(b) Notice. Any notice given hereunder by either party to the other shall be in writing and may be effected by personal delivery in writing or by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested when mailed to the proper party, at the following addresses:

- (c) Number and Gender Defined. As used in this Agreement, whenever the context so indicates, the masculine, feminine, or neuter gender and the singular or plural number shall each be deemed to include the others.
- (d) Entire Agreement. This Agreement contains the complete and entire Agreement between the parties respecting the matters addressed herein, and supersedes all prior negotiations, agreements, representations, and understanding, if any, between the parties respecting the joint construction of the Projects. This Agreement may not be modified, discharged, or changed in any respect whatsoever except by a further agreement in writing duly executed by authorized representatives of the parties hereto. All representations and indemnifications made in accordance with this Agreement, as well as all continuing obligations indicated in the Agreement, will survive completion and acceptance of the Project and termination or completion of this Agreement.
- (d) Effective Date. This Agreement takes effect upon full execution.
- (e) Other Instruments. The Parties agree that they will execute other and further instruments and documents as may become necessary or convenient to effectuate and carry out the purposes of this Agreement.
- (f) Invalid Provision. Any clause, sentence, provision, paragraph, or article of this agreement held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal, or ineffective shall not impair, invalidate, or nullify the remainder of this Agreement, but the effect thereof shall be confined to the clause, sentence, provision, paragraph, or article so held to be invalid, illegal, or ineffective.

#### **EXHIBIT "A"**

I. Background – The Neighborhood Partnering Program was established by a City Council Resolution (Number 20090924-072) directing the City Manager to, "develop a program which supports and enhances neighborhood improvement projects while better leveraging public resources." The Neighborhood Partnership Program cost-shares or provides grant assistance on projects of various scopes. Cost-sharing can be achieved through cash contributions to the City, in-kind professional services related to the project, and/or in-kind labor and maintenance.

The Adelphi Acre Community Garden submitted a qualified application to install a community garden on City of Austin right-of-way. The property is owned by the City of Austin Public Works Department.

The Project is located at 3701½ Adelphi Lane, Austin TX.

II. Project Cost Share —Adelphi Acre Community Garden will meet its cost share through Volunteer Hours, Cash donation, Donations of Professional Services, and In-kind Donations.

III. Details of Work & Project Implementation – The Adelphi Acres Community Garden will include:

- Design and installation of irrigation and water meter for the garden
- Garden site including fence, granite pathways, tool shed, and rain barrels

All improvements are to be constructed to City of Austin Standard Specifications and Details and in compliance with applicable ADA requirements.

The project will be implemented through internal service agreements with Public Works, Parks and Recreation Department, and/or through outside contracting, and from volunteer labor from the Adelphi Acre Community Garden. The City of Austin project manager has the responsibility for project implementation, management, and completion.

IV. Maintenance – Adelphi Acres Community Garden will be responsible for the maintenance of the project area for the life of the project.

Maintenance will include but is not limited to trash pickup, watering, trimming and upkeep of plantings, graffiti removal, and furnishing/installing any necessary materials required to maintain the original project, such as fencing, irrigation materials, lumber, crushed granite, etc.

If maintenance volunteer hours were included as part of the community's cost match, a summary of maintenance efforts, including recently dated pictures of the project, must be submitted annually for 2 years.

If the project is not properly maintained as deemed by the Director of Public Works, the City has the authority to remove any component of the project.

If this waiver and release is executed on behalf of a minor by a parent or guardian, it will serve and operate as a waiver and release of any liability for or claims of the minor child named below and his/her parents or guardians.
